

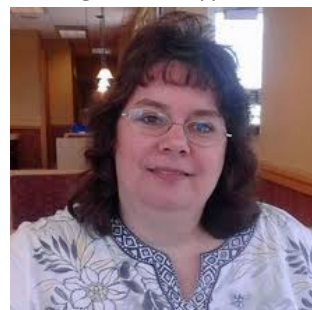

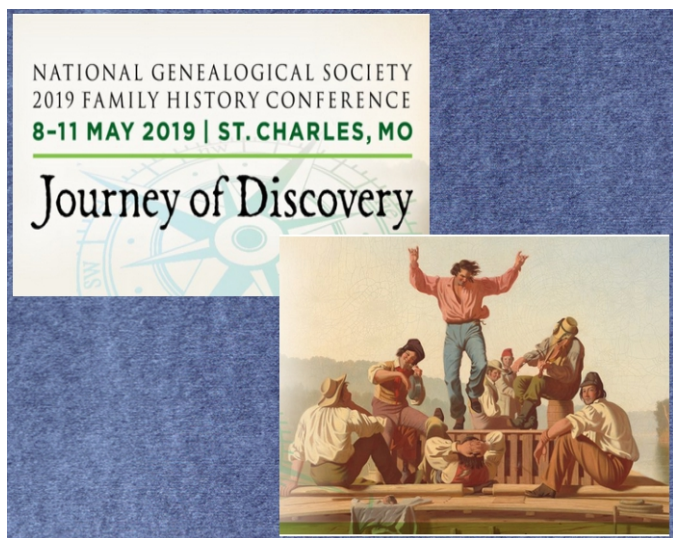

Joe Todd, Oklahoma History Center

An Oklahoma native, Todd served in the armed forces in Vietnam, and in Kuwait and Iraq during Desert Storm. He has received numerous awards and honors including the Bronze Star, Air Medal with four oak leaf clusters, Purple Heart, and the Vietnam Service and Presidential Unit Citation. Todd has worked at the Oklahoma Historical Society and the 45th Division Museum preserving documents and conducting oral histories. He currently volunteers at the Dwight D. Eisenhower Library interviewing World War II veterans. Todd has conducted more than 1,400 interviews to date and is the author of *USS Oklahoma, Remembrance of a Great Lady*, *Robert Huston: Oklahoma Rough Rider*, and numerous articles.
