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MUSKOGEE'S FIRST ARMISTICE DAY CELEBRATION

There was no city-wide celebration on the first Armistice Day. However, the American Legion, YMCA, the Kiwanis Club, and local schools all planned special events. The celebration was to begin at 10:59 a.m. with a blast of the siren at Muskogee Gas and Electric.

The American Legion planned a "smoker" at the Hotel Severs in the evening. All 400 members of Post James F. Smith were sent postcard invitations with the phrase "smoke and eat". Post commanders and adjutants of other posts in the county were also invited. W. F. Dugan provided music for the event.

The Kiwanis Club held its regular luncheon, in conjunction with the new Lions and Rotary Clubs, at the Severs Hotel and as many as 500 people were to attend. Adjutant General Charles F. Barrett was the guest of honor and there were other speakers and musical numbers on the program.

The YMCA provided music and fun. Beginning at 8 p.m. the National Guard regimental band and the city women's chorus gave musical programs. Lots of doughnuts and coffee were served. Plans to hold a noisy celebration after midnight were cancelled considering that the National Guard had to be called out the year before and several members of the social committee were taken away.

During the afternoon the Central high school orchestra and glee club gave a recital of patriotic music at the Hotel Severs and the Shriners band played in the evening.

Mayor John L. Wisener issued the following proclamation in honor of the day:

"On Tuesday, November 11, 1919, at 11:00 o'clock a.m., will occur the first anniversary of the signing of the Armistice, and it is planned by all the patriotic citizens of the United States to observe the most important event in our history in songs and gratitude, praise and thanksgiving, and the hope for a permanent peace.

That the City of Muskogee may assume her proper place among this multitude and co-operate in this great thanksgiving celebration, it is my hope and earnest request that every resident of our city take part and join with the nation to sing at this hour in memory of the signing of the Armistice, in memory of our fallen heroes and in memory of our victorious army."

HISTORY OF ARMISTICE DAY

World War I, or the Great War, officially ended with the Treaty of Versailles signed June 28, 1919, at the Palace of Versailles, France. However, fighting actually ended between the Allies and Germany seven months earlier with an armistice, or temporary cessation of hostilities. This armistice went into effect the 11th day of the 11th month of 1918. Therefore, November 18, 1918 is generally regarded as the end of the “war to end all wars”.

In November, 1919, President Wilson proclaimed November 11 as the first commemoration of Armistice Day. The original concept was for a day observed with parades and public meetings with a brief suspension of business beginning at 11:00 a.m. In an act approved by Congress May 13, 1938, the 11th of November was made a legal holiday to be dedicated to the cause of world peace and to be celebrated and known as “Armistice Day.”

This day was set aside to honor veterans of World War I but in 1954, after World War II had required the greatest mobilization of soldiers, sailors, Marines and airmen in the National’s history, and after American forces had fought aggression in Korea, the 83rd Congress amended the Act of 1938 by changing the name from Armistice Day to Veterans Day. With the approval of this legislation on June 1, 1954, November 11 became the day to honor American veterans of all wars.

On that same day, President Eisenhower sent a letter to the Honorable Harvey V. Higley, Administrator of Veterans’ Affairs, designating him as Chairman of the Veterans Day National Committee. In 1958 the White House advised the VA’s General Counsel that the 1954 designation of the VA Administrator as Chairman of the Veterans Day National Committee applied to all subsequent VA Administrators. Since March, 1989, when the VA was elevated to a cabinet level department, the Secretary of Veterans Affairs has served as the committee’s chairman.

Veterans Day continues to be observed on November 11, regardless of what day of the week on which it falls. Its important purpose: A celebration to honor America’s veterans for their patriotism, love of country, and willingness to serve and sacrifice for the common good.

Veterans Day Established

285 Letter to Harvey V. Higley, Administrator Of Veterans Affairs, Designating Him Chairman of The Veterans Day National Committee.

October 8, 1954

Dear Mr. Higley:

I have today signed a proclamation calling upon all of our citizens to observe Thursday, November 11, 1954 as Veterans Day. It is my earnest hope that all veterans, their organizations and the entire citizenry will join hands to insure proper and widespread observance of this day. With the thought that it will be most helpful to coordinate the planning, I am suggesting the formation of a Veterans Day National Committee. In view of your great personal interest as well as your official responsibilities, I have designated you to serve as Chairman. You may include in the Committee membership such other persons as you desire to select and I am requesting the heads of all departments and agencies of the Executive branch to assist the Committee in its work in every way possible.

I have every confidence that our Nation will respond wholeheartedly in the appropriate observance of Veterans Day, 1954.

First Sgt. Elmer New was 22 years old when he was killed by machine gun fire near St. Etienne, France, October 9, 1918. He was awarded the Croix de Guerre for extraordinary heroism displayed under fire.

Sgt. New had been the first in his community to volunteer for the U. S. Army. At the time he shipped out to France he was assigned to the 142nd Infantry Regiment, 36th Division. He arrived in France in July 1918 and had fought in the all-American Offensive-St. Mihiel Drive and then in the Meuse-Argonne Offensive where he was killed.

Born in Comanche, I.T. he grew up in Mustang, OK with his two brothers and two sisters. He also left a sweetheart making wedding plans for when he returned from the war.

On October 9, 1918, back in Oklahoma, Elmer's older sister awoke during the night and sat up in bed. She whispered to her husband that Elmer was not coming home alive from the war. Soon the body of Sgt. Elmer New was returned to his parents by two military honor escorts who remained on guard day and night until the burial. He is buried at Mustang Cemetery, Canadian Co. OK in the New family plot.

Interestingly the book "Oklahomans in WWI "The Spirit of 17", lists his burial location as the Argonne American Cemetery in France

J. R. Orr gravestone, Pleasant Valley Cemetery, Bedford Co. TN

The little Pleasant Valley Cemetery in Bedford County Tennessee rests near the Old Columbia Highway on Hopkins Bridge Road. It is a family cemetery, many graves display the same few surnames.

The gravestone for J. R. Orr simply states his birthday and the day he died. It stands near the gravestone of his wife and the mother of their seven children.

The old stone does not reveal that John Rufus Orr, husband and father of two babies, had enlisted in the 23rd Tennessee Infantry Regiment, Co. F., Confederate. He served from 1861-1865. The stone does not state that Lt. Orr fought at Murfreesboro, Chickamauga, and Shiloh and that his unit marched into Shiloh with 570 soldiers and later at the Appomattox surrender only four officers and 52 men stood for review.

The stone is also silent about Lt. Orr's time as a prisoner of war at Johnson Island, IL. He nearly froze to death there and had to eat rats in order to survive. But he did survive and returned to Bedford County to become a respected citizen, church leader, farmer and magistrate. After the war J. R. Orr fathered five more children, including my grandmother. So I am glad he made it through his wartime experiences.





Sgt Reckless - Korean War Horse Hero

A little Sorrel Filly (Mongolian Mare) purchased in South Korea in 1952 for \$250.00 from a Race Track by the 5th Marines. She was a chestnut brown mare with a white blaze on her face. Flame was renamed Sgt. Reckless by her troop, who trained her to transport ammunition, ignore artillery fire, avoid incoming fire, get into and out of military vehicles, even to string telephone wire! She was brought to the U.S.A. by a Private Company after the war. She lived out her life as a War Hero at Camp Pendleton, CA. Where she is buried. She had 4 Fools.

1st Marine Div.

Began Service: 1952 at age 5 years
Promoted to: Staff Sargent 1959
Retired: Nov. 10, 1960
with full military honors!

Reckless' decorations included two Purple Hearts, Good Conduct Medal, Presidential Unit Citation with star, National Defense Service Medal, Korean Service Medal, United Nations Service Medal, and Republic of Korea Presidential Unit Citation, all of which she proudly wore on her scarlet and gold blanket.

The story of Sgt Reckless. A horse so heroic during the Korean war she was promoted to Staff Sergeant by the Commandant of the US Marine Corps, and is listed alongside George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Martin Luther King, Mother Teresa and John Wayne as one of our all-time heroes.

ANOTHER GREAT HISTORY LESSON

This is the story...of our Mothers and Grandmothers who lived only 90 years ago.



Remember, it was not until 1920 that women were granted the right to go to the polls and vote.





The women were innocent and defenseless, but they were jailed nonetheless for picketing the White House, carrying signs asking for the vote. And by the end of the night, they were bare alive. Forty prison guards wielding clubs and their warden's blessing went on a rampage against the 33 women wrongly convicted of 'obstructing sidewalk traffic.'

(Lucy Burns)

They beat Lucy Burns, chained her hands to the cell bars above her head and left her hanging for the night, bleeding and gasping for air.

(Dora Lewis)

They hurled Dora Lewis into a dark cell, smashed her head against an iron bed and knocked her out cold. Her cell mate, Alice Cosu, thought Lewis was dead and suffered a heart attack. Additional affidavits described the guards grabbing, dragging, beating, choking, slamming, pinching, twisting and kicking the women.

Thus unfolded the "Night of Terror" on Nov. 15, 1917, when the warden at the Occoquan Workhouse in Virginia ordered his guards to teach a lesson to the suffragists imprisoned there because they dared to picket Woodrow Wilson's White House for the right to vote. For weeks, the women's only water came from an open pail. Their food—all of it colorless slop—was infested with worms.





(Alice Paul)

When one of the leaders, Alice Paul, embarked on a hunger strike, they tied her to a chair, forced a tube down her throat and poured liquid into her until she vomited. She was tortured like this for weeks until word was smuggled out to the press.

(Mrs. Pauline Adams)

In the prison garb she wore while serving a 60 day sentence.


