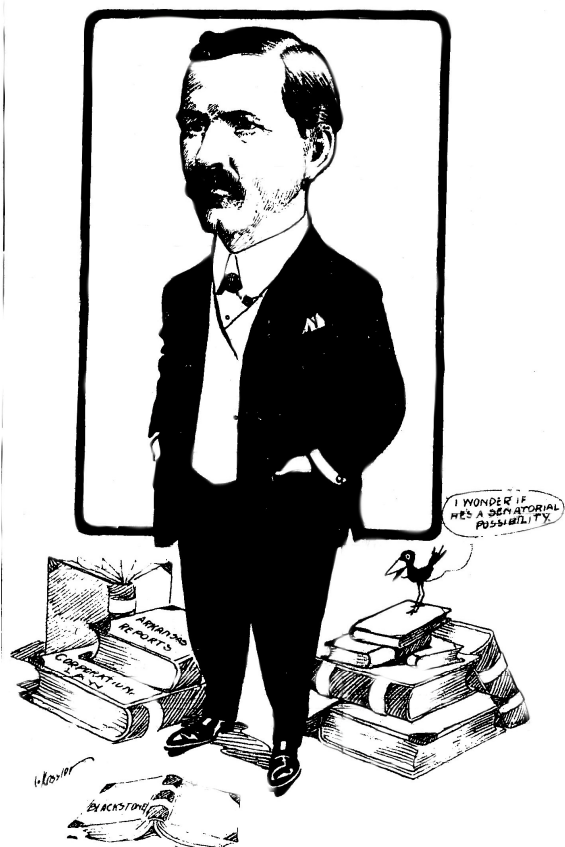

Transcription is from a copy of the article published in the Muskogee Daily Phoenix on Thursday Morning, February 16, 1905

Mr. Benjamin Martin, Jr., is a gifted lawyer, a fine reasoned and a close observer and student. He is particularly careful and conscientious in the preparation of his cases and is a valuable advisor in all legal matters. No safer counsellor can be had than Mr. Martin, and the knowledge of this fact has brought him a large practice. He was appointed first probate commissioner of the Norther district of the Indian Territory by Judge Springer and filled the office satisfactorily to all. He is a Knight Templar, steward of the M. E. church, south, and is interested in the banking and financial institutions of the city. He is besides a large owner of property and is much interested in the future of the city, in which he had faith and confidence.

Mr. Martin was born in Barnwell county, South Carolina in July 1873. He was educated at the public schools and Wofford College in his native state, and afterwards completed a law course in the Columbian University, Washington, D. C., from which he graduated and was admitted to the bar in 1897 and the same year licensed to practice in the Indian Territory.

Lulu Lee Morris was born August 1, 1918, to Joe and Rosa Morris in Badger Lee, Oklahoma. She went to join her heavenly father October 14, 2015. She was 97 years old.

Lulu graduated from Vian High School, Bacone College, and earned her B.A. and Master's Degree from Northeastern. She began her teaching career in 1943 at Wickett School, a one roomed rural school house just south of Webbers Falls. She taught one year in Seven Sisters, Texas, and then two years in Porter. She started teaching in Muskogee in 1949 at Sequoyah, later at Houston, ending her career at Franklin in 1968.

She married Roy Sallee in 1939. From that union one daughter, Linda Rose Sallee, was born. That marriage was dissolved. She married Earl Boggs February 1, 1946.

Lulu gave her life to Jesus at an early age. She joined First Baptist Church in 1950. She loved her church and church family.

Earl and Lulu loved to travel. They spent many years after retirement traveling across the United States for simple enjoyment and to libraries and cemeteries to work on her genealogy.

She started searching her ancestry in 1957. Her family has been blessed with research she has done on her Indian ancestry and her English ancestry. She has provided copies for each grandchild, and each great-grandchild.

Lulu Lee Boggs was the most loving mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, and great-great-grandmother.

Ruth (Gawf) Branum went home to be with the Lord on Friday, September 18, 2015, at the age of 106. She was born in Oktaha, Oklahoma, on August 16, 1909, and lived most of her life in Muskogee. Ruth and her husband Victor Branum were married in 1928 and were grocers for 30 years, opening their first store in Muskogee in 1929.

As a Christian woman, she saw the beauty of God's world in people, flowers and nature. She was a faithful member of the Church of Christ in Muskogee, serving as an elder's wife, mentor, children's Bible School teacher, and host to the loveliest wedding and baby showers. She was known for her gracious hospitality and beautiful gardens and strong faith. Ruth blessed friends and family with flowers, plants and produce for decades. She and her husband Vic were strong promoters of Oklahoma Christian University, where Vic was one of the original incorporators and Trustees.

Ruth was an active volunteer, dating from her days making bandages for soldiers during WWII. She volunteered at the Five Civilized Tribes Museum, Volunteers of America and Muskogee Regional Medical Center, as well as serving faithfully as a member of the Chandler Road Church of Christ.

The Rocky Mountain National Park is established by an act of the U.S. Congress.

The United States House of Representatives rejects a proposal to give women the right to vote.

February 12 – In Washington, D.C. the first stone of the Lincoln Memorial is put into place.

October 23 - 25,000 women march in New York City, demanding right to vote. [1]

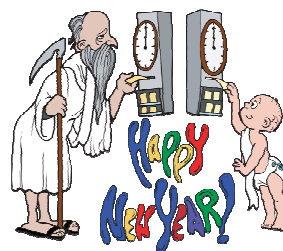
December 100,000,000th Ford Model T car is assembled. [1]

Bayer aspirin became available in tablet form, without a prescription.
