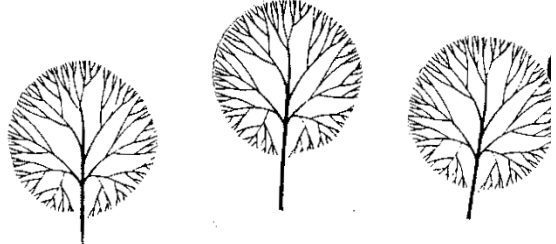

Mrs. Jessie Robb Hobart, First White
Child Born Here, is dead.

Mrs. Jessie Robb Hobart, 60, the first white baby born in Muskogee and a citizen of her native city during most of her life time, died Saturday night in Santa Barbara, Calif. according to an Associated Press dispatch to the Phoenix last night.

Coincidentally, her birth as Muskogees first white babe Occured at almost exactly the time that the little community, which has grown into the modern city of today, came into being.

It was entirely fitting that the distinction should have been hers, because to her parents, the late Mr. and Mrs. Andrew Robb, as much as to any other individuals, was given credit by pioneer citizens last

night for having laid the foundation which made possible the Muskogee that those of today know.

During recent years Mrs. Hobart had not made her home here and her contacts, though maintained as closely as conditions would permit, had been comparatively limited. But old timer's related that Muskogee was her first love and they recalled that she was the prime mover several years ago in an effort which resulted in an organization, of "old timer's" here.

Mrs. Hobart's father, pioneer's were agreed, always must be numbered among the more distinguished citizens of eastern Oklahoma and of Muskogee in particular. He was a native of Pennsylvania, where he was born in 1840, and his career was a colorful one until, after the time that he was associated in partnership in the opening of what was said to be the first business establishment in Muskogee.

When a boy of 13, he was in Iowa. The opening of the civil war found him in Kansas. He enlisted immediately and served throughout the war, being discharged with the rank of Lieutenant. He entered the mercantile business in

Kansas and remained there until 1871 when he became interested in eastern Oklahoma, then the Indian Territory, because he realized that the Katy railroad, then under construction would mean the opening of a vast virgin territory.

In 1871 he was associated in the opening of the Atkinson and Company, general store here, and in 1875, became manager of James Patterson Merchantile Company, with which he remained until the time of his death. He had been married in 1865 and with him he brought to Muskogee to the first residence constructed here, - his wife and two daughters, Molly and Kate.

The railroad was built through Muskogee in 1872, and it was in Decmeber of that year that Jessie the "Muskogee Baby" was born. It was an event which aroused the little community to excitement and celebration.

The late Miss Alice Robertson, later postmistress and congresswomen, was the godmother, and later the school teacher of the child.

Mrs. Hobart's life was that typical of the frontier child, young woman, and young matron. She had exceptional educational opportunities for one on the frontier, however, because her brother in law was the late Dr. H.F. Evans, husband of Kate, and for many years president of Henry Kendall college, which later was moved to Tulsa and became the present Tulsa University, Jessie was married in 1902 to D.H. Hobart of Claremore, who was fatally injured in an automobile accident four years ago.

Her survivors, include a daughter, Mrs. Clarence W. Swanson of Oklahoma City. Word as to funeral plans had not been received last night.

Many business men of the city followed their former friend to the grave. As the casket was rested above the grave, the Woodmen placed a large box covered with flowers on the casket.

When the minister closed with the words "and his spirit shall return to the Lord" the box of flowers opened and a white pigeon flew out and winged its way towards the clouds.

Half of the pall bearers were member of the Elks Lodge and the other of Woodman of the World.
