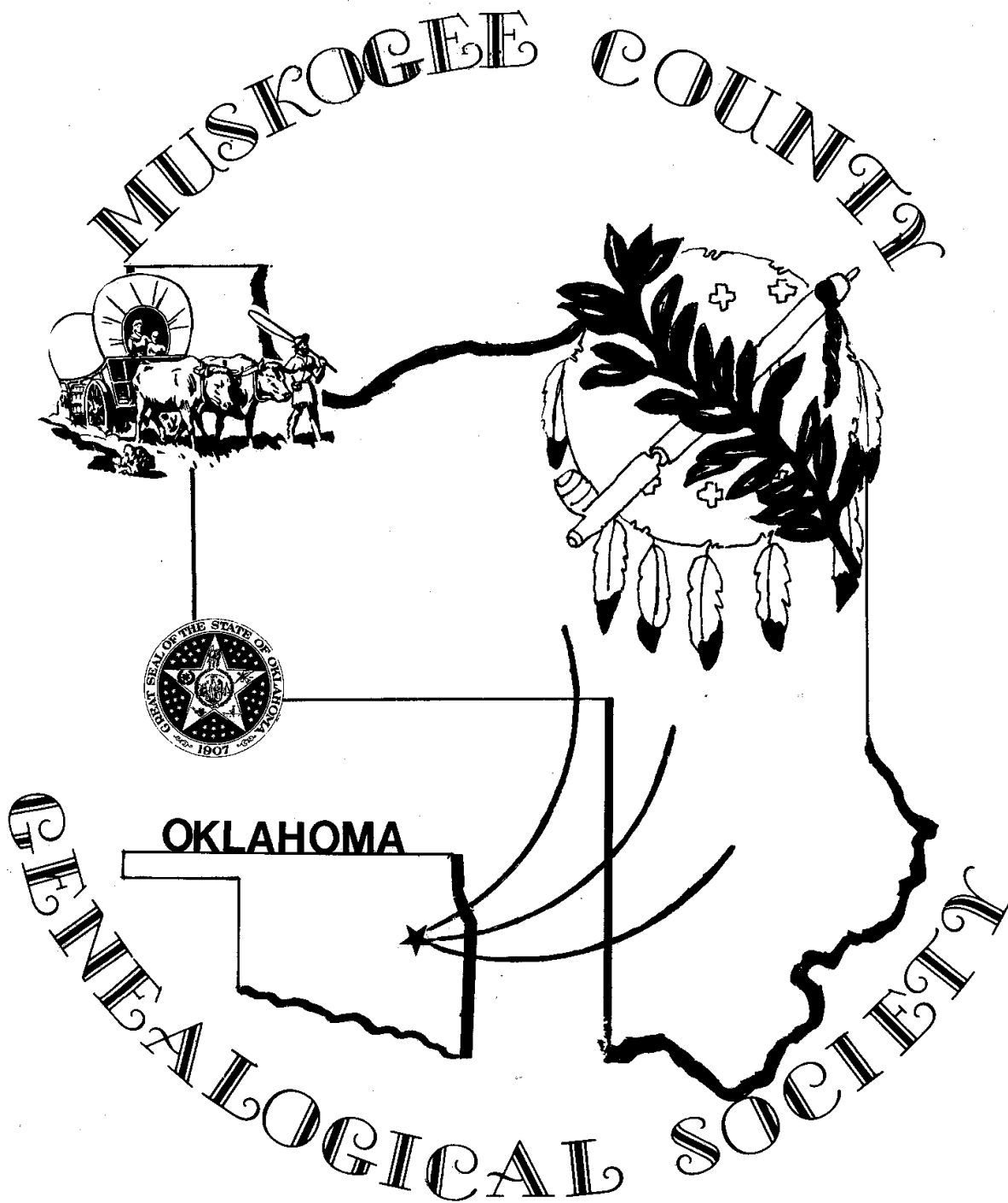

A charting of cemeteries has been made and one of our fall projects will be recording those that have not been read. One of our members has been listing and locating those cemeteries. We will be asking for help in this endeavor. One of the purposes of our society is to discover and preserve any material that may establish or illustrate the history of Muskogee County and its families. In preserving cemetery records, we will be taking a step toward this goal.

Muskogee Weekly Phoenix notice:
Nov. 1889

Notice is hereby given that all mechanics, physicians, dentists and all other professional men engaged in any particular profession or calling are required by law to pay an occupation tax of \$2.00 per month during their residence in this Nation. All persons coming under this head who refuse or fail to comply with the requirements of the permit law are declared intruders of Treaty of 1866 entered in between the Creek Nation and the United States Government and are liable to expulsion from the Creek Nation.*

All citizens who have in their employ or who may hereafter employ non-citizens or common laborers are required by law to pay a permit of \$1.00 per month for each non-citizen employed.

All permits are required to be renewed within 15 days after their expiration.

* There was some enforcement of this law, as there are a few notices of auctioning off property of some expelled non-citizens. There was also a \$100.00 fine if this wasn't complied with by the citizens of the Creek Nation.

Muskogee Weekly Phoenix Nov. 25, 1897

Thanksgiving editorial (in part)...We all have cause to be thankful today. The year has been one of general prosperity, and in no part of the Union has prosperity been more in evidence than right down here in the wild and woolly, big and beautiful Indian Territory. Crops have been unusually good, health has been generally good, and peace, plenty and happiness have stalked hand and hand throughout this length & breadth of the Tribes Civilized...The United States Courts, the Dawes Commission and Union Agency have all been grinding away trying to civilize us, and while we can't see much tangible good as a result from this constant pecking, we presume the hidden result will someday be apparent, and hence we are thankful for Uncle Sam's helping hand...

EX-DEPUTY U.S. MARSHALS' ASSOCIATION

Below is a roster of the Ex-Deputy, U.S. Marshals of Indian Territory, whose association held its last meeting in the Federal Bldg., in Tulsa, November 19, 1930. W.F. Jones (U.S. Deputy Marshall 1897-1917) was chairman of the committee to investigate federal records and compile a roster of living ex-deputy U.S. Marshals who had served in the Indian Territory before statehood. According to Mr. Jones there were only two copies of this roster made, one was in his possession and a copy that was given to Congressman Wesley E. Disney.

Committee reported: "In the records available we find the following names recorded; there, may, however, possibly be (not exceeding ten) more names found elsewhere but at this time (1930) we are unable to make a report on these men."

All the following are men who served as Commissioned Deputy U.S. Marshals in the different districts composing the Indian Territory, and all are now living:

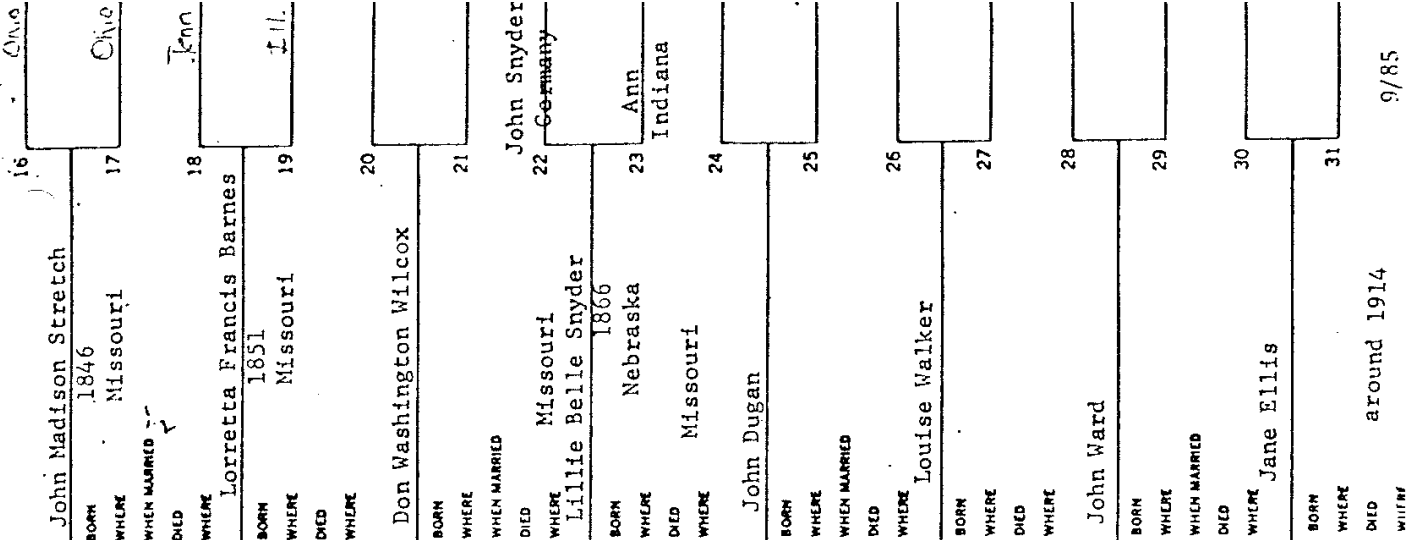
