LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

Another calendar year is drawing close for our society. This is the last quarterly for our current membership. A renewal form for the years 1991-1992 is included. We hope you will continue to support your society with your membership and input.

We continue to ask for your contributions to the quarterly. Pictures, short stories, and anecdotes relating to your Muskogee County ancestors are solicited and appreciated.

Our monthly meetings have been very well attended. The programs have been "Beginner's Workshop" by Mickey Hagan; Deputy County Clerk, Mary Hughes; "Photography" by Eddie Rauniker; U.S. Marshal Larry Beard; "Early History of Plantation Families Along the Arkansas" by Troy Poteete; and a program concerning microfilming by a representative of the Utah Genealogy Society.

The remaining programs will be "How Tax Lists Can Help in Your Research" by Mrs. Hoover Rowsey; "Oklahoma Land Run" by Burneta Vanosdel; "Show n'Tell; "Patriotic Societies" and in June we will have a "Hands On Workshop" at the Family History Center.

One of our major accomplishments this year has been the preparation for Muskogee County Records to be microfilmed by the Utah Genealogical Society. It has not been an easy task and the volunteers were required to obtain permission from Record Holders and also inventory the material. These volunteers are to be commended for their over 160 hours of work. We do not know when the microfilmers will come to do their work, but it is a satisfaction to know that this material will be available to researchers all over the world.

Without volunteers we would be nothing. We now have members entering veteran and spouse burials into the computer at the Ft. Gibson National Cemetery. The society will receive a printout of these burials when the work is done. Two members are volunteering their time in the genealogy room at the library two days a week. Queries that come to the society and the library are answered by society members. An ancestor chart and a surname file are kept current by volunteers. The publishing and the distribution of the quarterly by our editor and assistant editor requires a tremendous amount of time. There is always a need for more help. If you feel you could donate some of your time, please let us know.

Board Meetings are held the first Friday of each month, 9:30 a.m. in the Conference Room at the Muskogee Public Library. Your presence at these meetings is encouraged. Come and see the workings of your society.

In May, a new president and Board of Management will be installed. I look back and feel good about this year. Participation has been great, friendships have been established and my heartfelt thanks go out to you for making our society a success. I have enjoyed the year as president.

Myra DeVee Vanderpool Gormley of Tacoma, Wash., is a member of the Muskogee County Genealogical Society. She is a native of Muskogee and a 1957 Central High School graduate. The 1957 Chieftain Yearbook shows DeVee Vanderpool participating in debate, pep squad, sophmore, junior and senior plays, Oklahoma Girls State 1956, Scout Staff (the student newspaper), and various other activities.

Since moving away in 1958 she has worked as a reporter and advertising copywriter, a printer for the San Antonio Light, the Seattle Times and Stars and Stripes in Darmstadt, West Germany and is currently a newspaper columnist, writing about her favorite subject, genealogy. Her weekly column, "Shaking Your Family Tree", is distributed by the Los Angeles Times Syndicate, appearing in newspapers throughout the country. She also writes

about family history for Colonial Homes magazine. Gormley has been a guest on television and radio programs in New York, Los Angeles, Seatle, Salt Lake City, Kansas City, and in Canada. She has addressed numerous genealogical conferences on the subject of genetics and genealogy. She is a member of more than a dozen genealogical societies, including the Association of Professional Genealogists, New England Historic Genealogical Society, American Name Society and National Genealogical Society in Arlington, Virginia.

Gormley published "Family Diseases: Are you at Risk?" in 1989. The book, written in popular style, examines the genetics revolution and its implications for your health. It also discusses genetic diseases and whether you and your family may be at risk. She was the 1990 first place winner of the category "Newspaper Columns of General Interest" in the Excellence-In-Journalism Competition sponsored by the Council of Genealogy Columinists.

Through Gormley's article in the Nov/Dec 1990 Heritage Quest, "Networking: Via PRODIGY, An Electronic Bulletin Board", we find she has taken on still another project -- writing a weekly column dealing with genealogical research exclusively for Prodigy's genealogy bulletin board.

If you're wondering what's the big deal about genealogy, Gormley said it is because genealogy is an addictive hobby, once you start. Her lifelong fascination with genealogy was sparked by her father, John Vanderpool, who was a genealogist, and ignited by the stories her grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Charlie Fricks, used to tell her and by the televised production of Alex Haley's book "Roots".

From her grandmother, she heard tales of what it was like to travel from Alabama to Oklahoma Indian Territory in 1892. And from her grandfather, she heard stories about her great-grandfather who fought in the Civil War as a teen-ager, and how the family farm in northwestern Georgia was destroyed during Sherman's march to Atlanta. "These stories made history come alive for me. From there I had to find out how to become a researcher," Gormley said.

Gormley has been generous in her contributions to the genealogy room of the Muskogee library. In addition to a sizeable number of books donated, she gave a one day seminar on August 1, 1987 from which our society earned \$781.00 to purchase books. 151 participants came from Muskogee and 27 surrounding Oklahoma towns, plus two from Missouri. All who expressed appreciation said it was the best they had ever attended and the president at the time, when recognized at other meetings, is still asked "When are you having another like it?"

By way of introduction, I am an official historian of Forsyth County, Georgia, where a large population of Cherokee mixed-bloods lived before and after the removal period in 1838-39. I have been engaged in Cherokee research on many of these families for over 20 years.

Earlier this year, I published "Cherokee Planters In Georgia, 1832-1838," which covers the 11 counties of northwest Georgia created in 1832-33 from the Cherokee Nation surveys.

At present I am writing a volume of Cherokee history/genealogy titled "Unhallowed Intrusion."
