DEAD MAN GROANS AND WINKS AT UNDERTAKER  
SHOT BY OFFICERS,  
MAN THOUGHT DEAD,  
CHEATS EMBALMER

Floyd Heitz (Heytz), Alleged House  
Breaker taken to Undertaker  
'LIMP AS A RAG'

Embalming fluid and Knives  
Brought to "Slab" when Ex-Soldier  
Bats His Eyes and Comes to life

Heitz ran for about 100 yards and then fell. The policemen rushed up to him. "I'm shot in the lungs," Heitz gasp, "don't shoot again." Then Heitz ceased to breath. The police called an ambulance and Heitz was taken to the Street-Eicholtz undertaking parlor to be embalmed.

KNIFE MADE READY

He was laid upon the embalming table and his eyes were closed in "eternal sleep." The clinking of steel could be heard as the undertaker laid his knives upon his breast to begin the operation for embalming, and draining pans rattled as they were put into place.

With knife in hand the undertaker was ready to make his first cut--- and then Floyd Heitz opened his eyes, gurgled and spoke, "I'm shot in the lung. Don't shoot any more," he said.

The knives dropped to the floor. The undertaker stared at the police; the police stared at the undertaker. For several moments no one spoke. The attendants began undressing Heitz to determine how severely he was wounded. A scratch under his nose where he had been cut by a clothes line while attempting to escape were all they found. They turned him over on his back and carefully examined him again. Not a bullet had touched him.

Heitz is a well known police character and has been held in jail here several times on charges of vagrancy.

He appeared at the Fisher home last night about 10' oclock and asked if he could borrow a rain coat as it was raining.

WANTED RAINCOAT

"I had the porch light on," Mrs. Fisher said, "when he came to the door and knocked. I went to the door and asked him what he wanted and he asked if any of the men folks had a raincoat he could borrow. He said it was raining and he needed one. I had never seen the man before, so I closed the door after telling him that I had one and I called the police. When the police came he cried, 'My God, Mrs. Fisher don't you know me? I drilled a well on your husband's farm'".

Police said when they drove up Heitz started to run and they gave pursuit. After running about half a block they began firing. Heitz ran about 100 yards when he fell. "I'm shot" he moaned.

"When we ran to him he was laying on his side," Plainclothesman Brown said. "He told us he was shot in the lung and asked us not to shoot him again. We called the ambulance round and we all thought he was dead. We called the ambulance and while it was coming we carried him to the corner of N street

and East Okmulgee. He never said a word and we could not tell that he was breathing."

In Heitz' clothes were found a goodly amount of drugs and a hypodermic needle. Police say they had several calls in the last few nights of a man filling the description of Heitz trying to break into houses on the west side of town.

#### SECOND TIME DEAD

After rising from the embalming table Heitz was taken to the police station where he was given stimulants and was soon able to talk.

Last night's experience was Heitz' second of the kind in the last few years. After he recovered consciousness at the city jail last night he was able to talk to City Physician J.I. Hollingsworth who told him of his narrow escape from the undertaker.

"Ain't that rich? Did they honestly have me down there ready to embalm me?" he ask. "That's the second time. When I was coming home from Honolulu in the Fifth Cavalry they had me in the death ward of the transport. When I woke up an undertaker had his knife in his hand just looking for a good place to stick it in me.

I knew what was going on but I couldn't say a word. I winked hard and finally managed to get the plate off of one eye. When that fellow finally saw me winking he left that part of the ship. I had been 'dead' two days then. He got the captain and they put me in hot water and I came out of it".

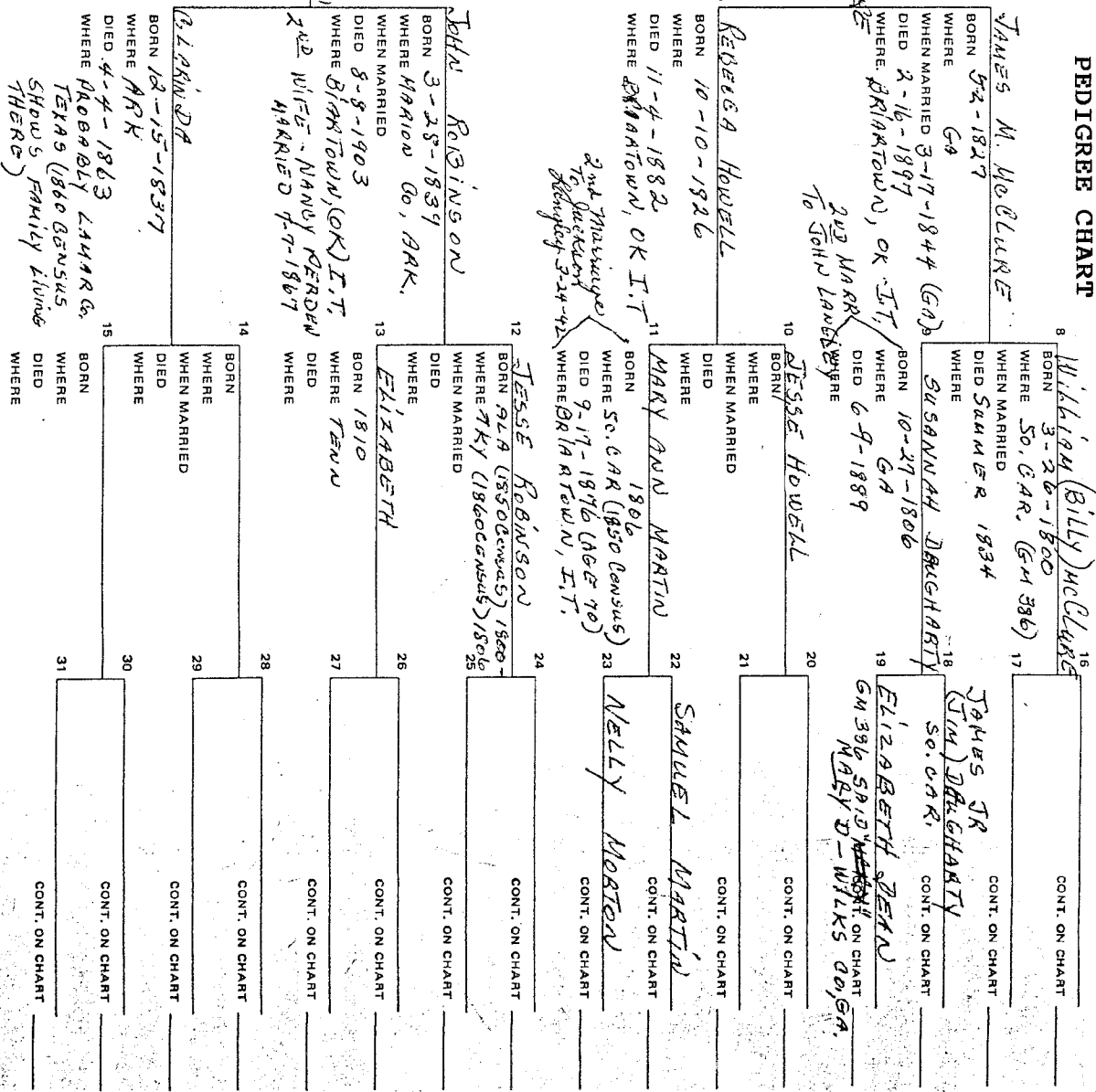
