April 15, 1921. Miss Eula WEBB and Mr. Claude J. DODGE of this city, were united in marriage at the home of the bride's sister, Mrs. J.C. MULHALL, in Okmulgee Sunday, Rev. WALTERS officiating. The bride is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. R. WEBB, of this city. She has grown to womanhood here. For the past eight years she has been employed in the post office and for the past three years she has been town treasurer. The groom has been a resident of Boynton for the past year and a half coming here from Porum, his former home. He is employed by Transcontinental Oil Company and was recently appointed acting postmaster on the recommendation of Hon. Alice M. ROBERTSON, who has known him since childhood. Mr and Mrs. DODGE immediately went to housekeeping in a home they had prepared on East Kenefick Avenue.

A prominent resident of Braggs, Indian Territory, Solomon BRAGGS was born in Logan County, Ohio, October 19, 1827. He was the son of John and Rebecca (Cox) BRAGGS.

The family moved from Ohio to Illinois in 1836, locating near Lebanon, St. Clair County, where the eight children were educated. Brothers of Solomon were Elijah, William, Thomas, John A.J., More, and Samuel. His only sister, Angeline, married John R. Mize and resided in Pike City, Arkansas. Solomon's mother died about 1837 and his father in 1870.

For several years, Solomon was a trusty scout and spy for the Union forces during the Civil War. His first service was under Colonel William H. BISSELL, when he enlisted in 1846 for the Mexican War. In 1862, he enlisted in the Third Wisconsin Cavalry, from which he was honorably discharged in 1865. He took part in the battles of Cabin Creek, Cany Springs, Battle of Sabine in PRICE'S last raid and many other encounters.

In 1866, Mr. BRAGGS moved to Indian Territory, where he took up farming. March 17, 1867, he married Mrs. Elizabeth (Brand) CUMMINGS, the widow of Theodore CUMMINGS. Mrs. CUMMINGS had a daughter, Katy who married Mr. Edwin WREN in 1854. The WREN family was well known throughout the county. The WRENS were parents of four children, William Theodore, George Howard, Charles Rogers and Edwin Bragg.

Mrs. BRAGGS was the daughter of George W. and Elizabeth (Rogers) BRAND, the former a native of Virginia and the latter was born in the Cherokee Nation. Mrs. BRAGGS was born June 4, 1827. Her death date is not known, but a stone bearing her birth date is found in South Bethel Cemetery in Braggs, along with her husband, Solomon.<sup>1</sup>

OBITUARY OF SOLOMON BRAGGS

The Pioneer is Dead at the Age of 84 Years.

Braggs, I.T. Jan 10. - (Special) Mr. Solomon BRAGGS, one of the oldest inhabitants and the one from whom this town takes its name, died yesterday at his home from heart failure. He was 84 years old and for many years has been a very prominent citizen in this town and much of the upbuilding of it is due to his efforts.

Mr. BRAGGS came to this country at the close of the Mexican War in which he had served. Later he enlisted in Gen. BLUNT'S command and served throughout the Civil War in the Federal Army in Arkansas and Louisiana.

He received a commission as United States Marshal during President Cleveland's first administration and had several desperate encounters with bandits and outlaws that infested the country between Fort Smith and Muskogee at that time, and succeeded in driving out many of them.<sup>2,3</sup>

The Grant Foreman Room contains a valuable tool for the genealogical researcher in the form of two card indexes to several newspapers published in Muskogee County. Of initial interest is the obituary index along the east wall. This index covers the following periods of the Phoenix newspaper.

1888 Feb 23 - 1902 Dec 25  
1929 Mar 4 - 1930 Jan 15  
1930 Jan 16 - 1935 May 4  
1935 May 5  
1955 - Present

The 1888 - 1902 data has been published by Sheri Sharpnack Siebold in the three volume edition of Genealogical Data extracted from the "Muskogee Weekly Phoenix" Indian Territory. The 1930 - 1935 portion of the index was published in 1988 by the Muskogee County Genealogical Society as Index of Deaths extracted from Muskogee Daily Phoenix. Both publications can be found in the genealogical collection on the Oklahoma shelves.

References to ancestors' daily lives may be found along the west wall in the topical index. This index is composed of an older project developed by the WPA before 1940 and an on-going project to index the Phoenix. The list of older indexed newspapers below is based on a sampling of the entries created by the WPA staff and is not a definitive statement of beginning or ending dates.

There is another index of Muskogee newspapers in Oklahoma City in the Oklahoma Historical Society. It too is in a card format, but I have been advised consideration is being given to having it microfilmed in the near future. It was created by WPA staff before World War II. The following is a list provided by OHS which will serve to outline which titles and years were indexed. It is not clear whether a single issue or the full run for each year was covered for each year listed as being indexed. Not having seen the index personally, I suspect it is topically like the WPA era portion of the topical index in the Grant Foreman Room, i.e., broad subject categories.
