“The Little Brown Book” by Paul Betow


My first introduction to genealogy was in grade school when my father shared with me information about his side of the family. My grandfather had taken the time to document his family genealogy in “the little brown book”. I transcribed the information from that little brown book for a grade school report. Although it only went back two generations, it was very detailed including medical information, dates and names of rivers and cities. I still have the grade school report, handwritten and with the proper umlauts over every ‘u’ in the name Butow.

A little over two years ago, my interest in Genealogy resurfaced and I attended a Beginner’s Genealogy workshop hosted by the Muskogee County Genealogical Society. Soon afterwards, I enlisted the help of my parents, Lowell and Wanda, to make contact with their cousins to gather as much existing genealogy information as they could find. Scores of large manila envelopes continue to fill my mailbox. This past summer, I received a 60 page Personal Ancestry File (PAF) from Dorothy Franks of Lathrop, Missouri sent to me by my mother. Dorothy has documented my mother’s connection to the Robinson and Barham families of Logan County, Kentucky (1820) and to the Duncan families of Marion/Fayette Counties, Illinois (1840). Earlier this year, I received a smaller but very significant envelope with copies of newspaper obituaries obtained by my father for his grandparents, Carl Louis Betow and Daniel Abraham dated early 1900’s from Iowa and Wisconsin.

This past weekend, I hopped onto the computer internet and visited the homepage for Family Tree Maker. At the last Muskogee County Genealogical Society Board meeting, there was some discussion about the search tool located at this homepage called FamilyTree Finder. I rarely have much luck finding Betows or Butows on the internet. I was pleasantly surprised when I found quite a few located on CD-ROMs within the World Family Tree collection. And luckily, all of them were said to be on one CD, Volume 11. I’ve ordered the CD and I will have to keep my fingers crossed. CONSOLIDATED LEDGER RECORDS OF BULLITT FOREMAN

The following death dates were on ledger sheets found in the attic of the old Bullitt Foreman home near the Carlile community east of Gore, Sequoyah County, Oklahoma. Bullitt Foreman was a Judge in Illinois District, Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory in 1889 and 1891. He was the great-grandfather of Ed Henshaw, Rte. 7, Box 76, Vian, Oklahoma. Mr. Henshaw and his wife, Gwen, now live in the original home. According to Mr. Henshaw, George Bullitt Foreman, Jr. was an undertaker from 1875 to 1924 and the ledgers most probably were from Bullitt Foreman, Jr.'s store.

The original ledger sheets are in Mr. Henshaw's possession and are thought to have come from the source above or from a Foreman store in either Gore or Webbers Falls. Many lists were duplicated. When more than one date or name is given, it is the result of consolidation of those lists on which conflicting dates were recorded. In the interest of history and genealogy, all dates are included thus remaining to be authenticated by further research. The names were left as they were spelled on the ledger sheets. Mr. Henshaw has kindly given permission for these sheets to be transcribed and published.
